Fly High Stories is committed to making environmental sustainability a core part of its practice.

We encourage all members of the company, whether they be founding members or those employed on a particular project, to think about their own impact on the planet and invite them to suggest ways we can make positive change.

Our environmental commitments include:

- Reducing our carbon emissions and researching carbon off-setting;
- Using public transport and other sustainable transport wherever possible;
- Using reclaimed materials for set and costume and trying to pass them on to other organisations after we have finished with them. If that is not possible, we aim to use as many materials that are recyclable in order to reduce wastage and landfill;
- Banning single-use plastics and disposable, non-compostable items from the rehearsal room and on tour and making sure that any plastics, metals, paper and card that are used are recycled appropriately;
- Making work that has a positive social and environmental message and using our educational materials to support this in a practical way;
- Encouraging our partners (funders, venues etc) to share our environmental vision;
- Producing educational materials on recycled paper and giving audiences the option of downloading materials onto their personal devices instead;
- Encouraging our audiences to consider their own carbon footprint when coming to see our work by thinking about their transport options;
- Signing up to 'Julie's Bicycle' in order to monitor and evaluate the environmental impact of our work on a project by project basis.
